Duration 1 hour and 15 minutes



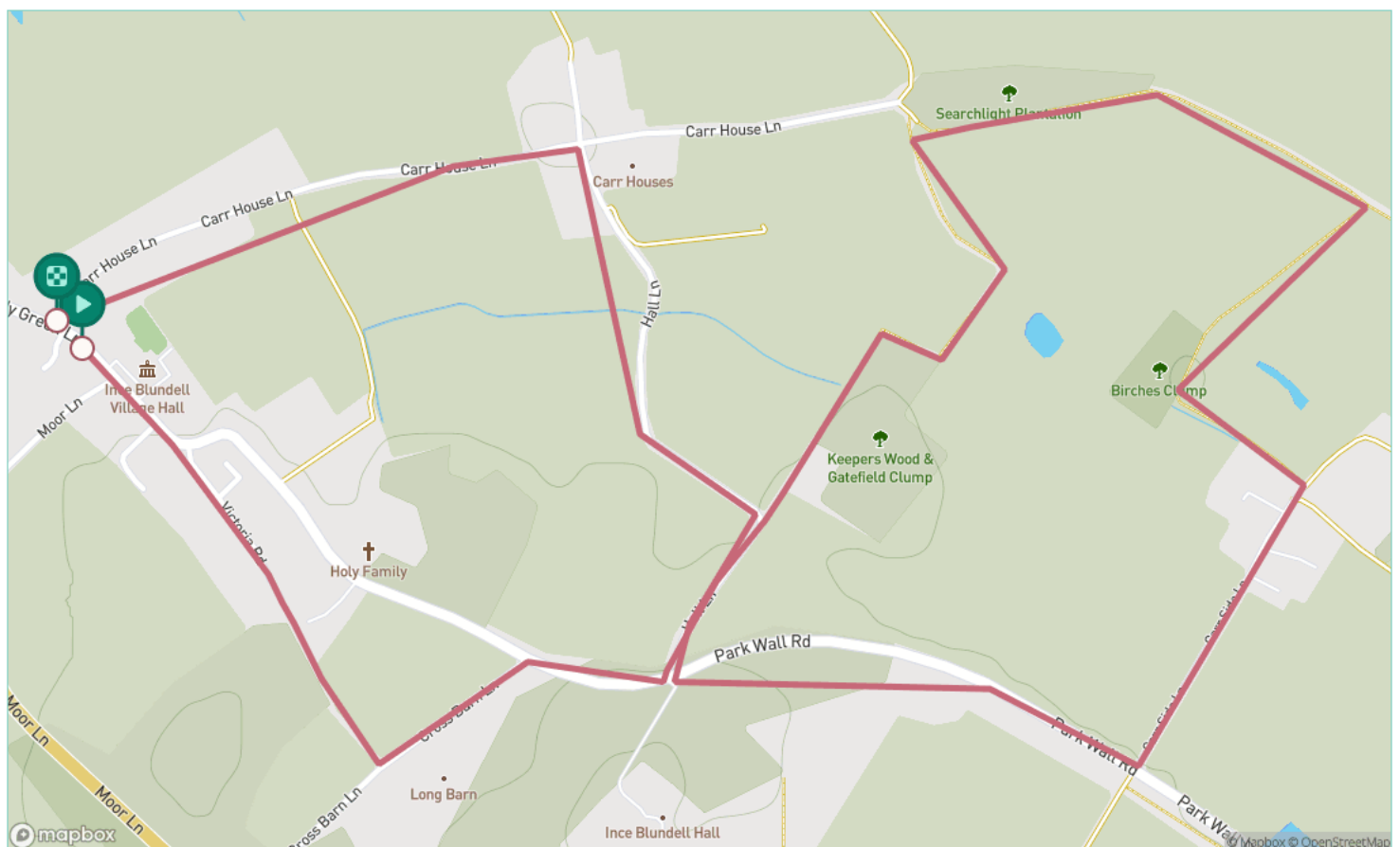

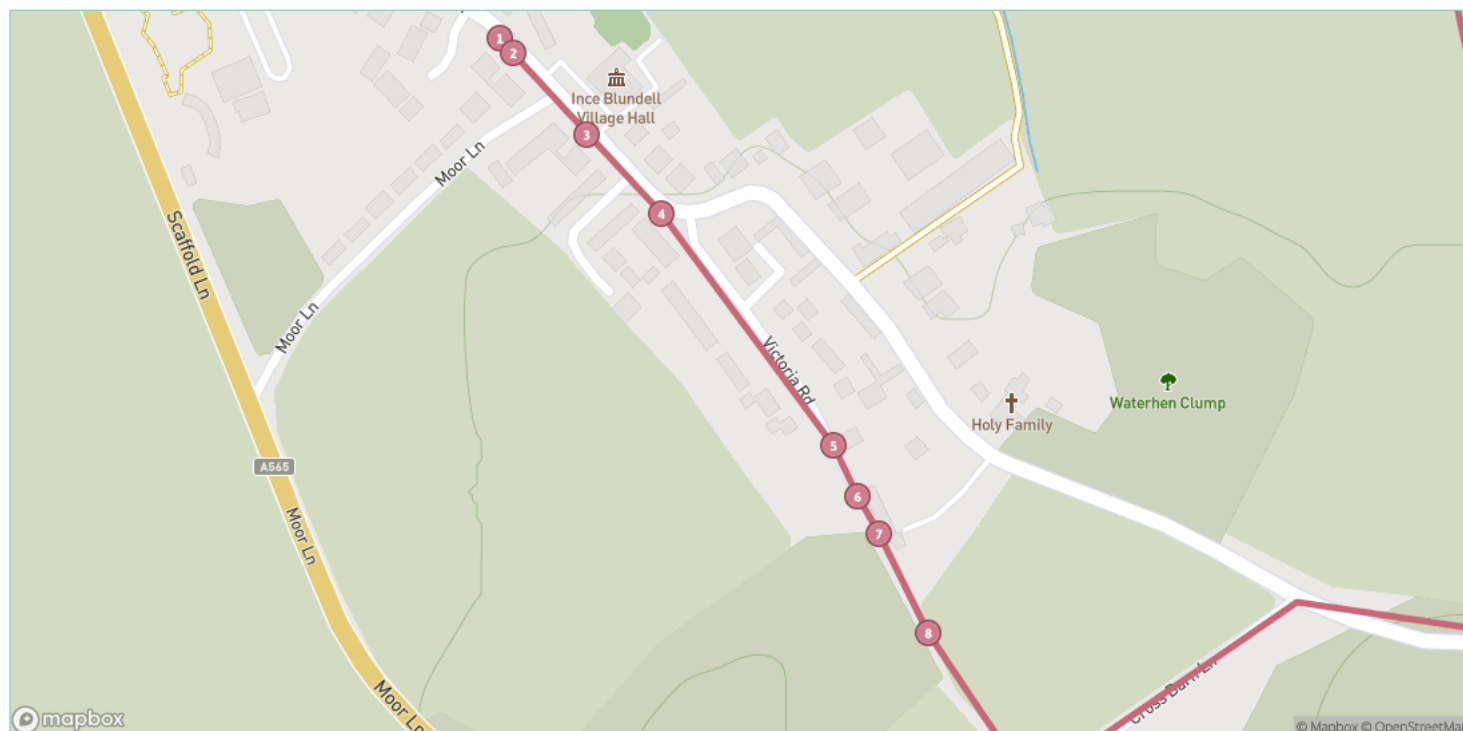

Disclaimer: Directions are provided as guidance only. Weather, construction, closures or other factors may affect routes.
Please take care when crossing roads and avoid private land. Always follow local signage and use common sense.
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Step 1: Start your walk from the bus stops on Lady Green Lane.

Step 2: The number 47 bus takes you into central Liverpool and on to Crossens. There are usually two busses every hour.

Step 3: Look left and see the Sunshine Tea Rooms.

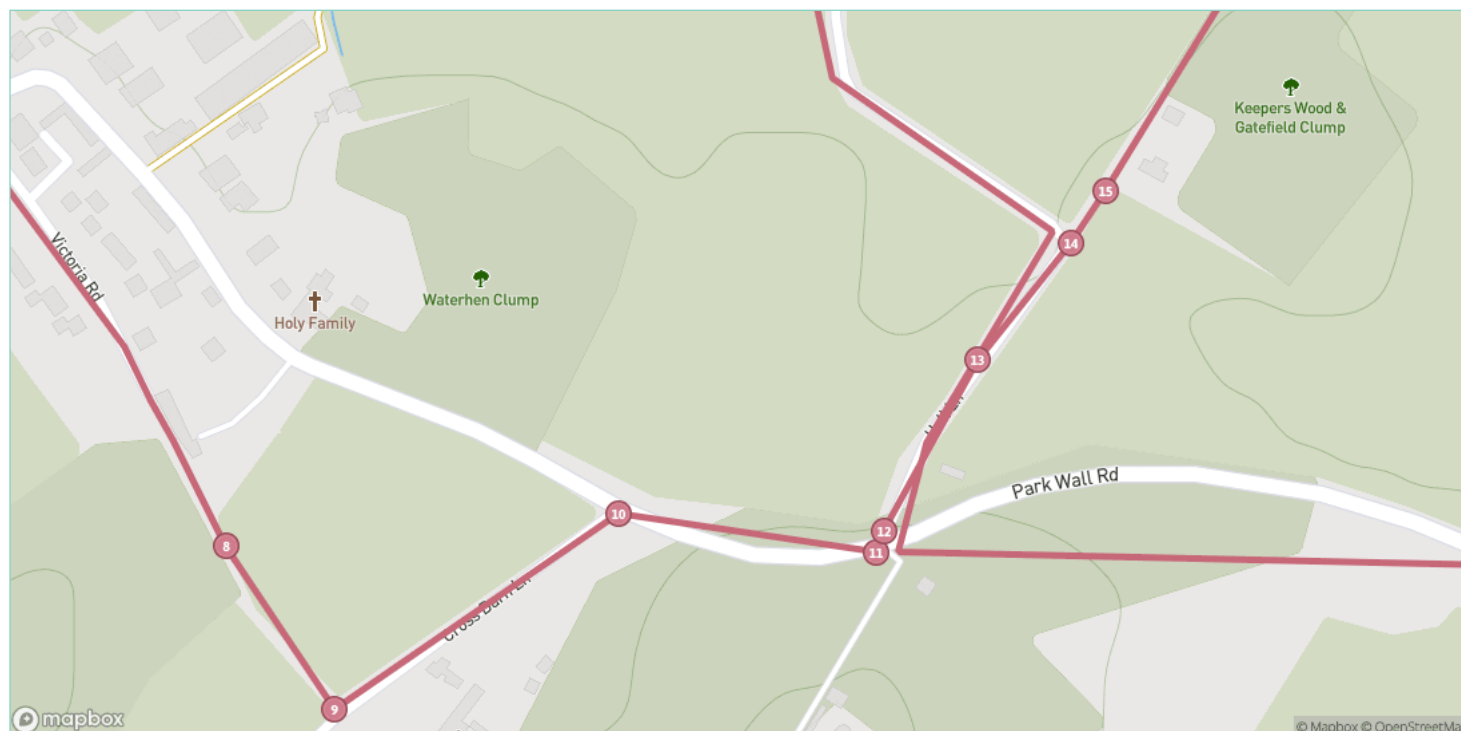
Step 4: At left hand bend continue straight on down Victoria Road which is a cul-de-sac. No pavements so be aware of moving vehicles.

Step 5: Donkeys were spotted in one of the fields on Victoria Road.

Step 6: At the end of Victoria Road there is a footpath that leads you through a wooden kissing gate.

Step 7: Continue along the footpath

Step 8: There is a narrow footpath alongside a field, it will bring you out onto Cross Barn Lane.



Step 9: Turn left onto Cross Barn Lane, uneven road.

Step 10: Turn right on to Back O the Town Lane and walk along the pavement.

Step 11: When you arrive at Ince Blundell Hall entrance, cross the road and walk onto Hall Lane opposite.

Step 12: Hall Lane has no pavements so be aware of moving vehicles.

Step 13: Continue along the lane until you arrive at Keepers Cottage.

Step 14: It may look like you are walking up a driveway, however at the cottage gates there is a footpath on the left.

Step 15: Footpath entrance



Step 16: The path leads you through the woods and out onto a narrow path running along the edge of a field.

Step 17: Follow the fence line around to the left towards the line of trees in the distance.

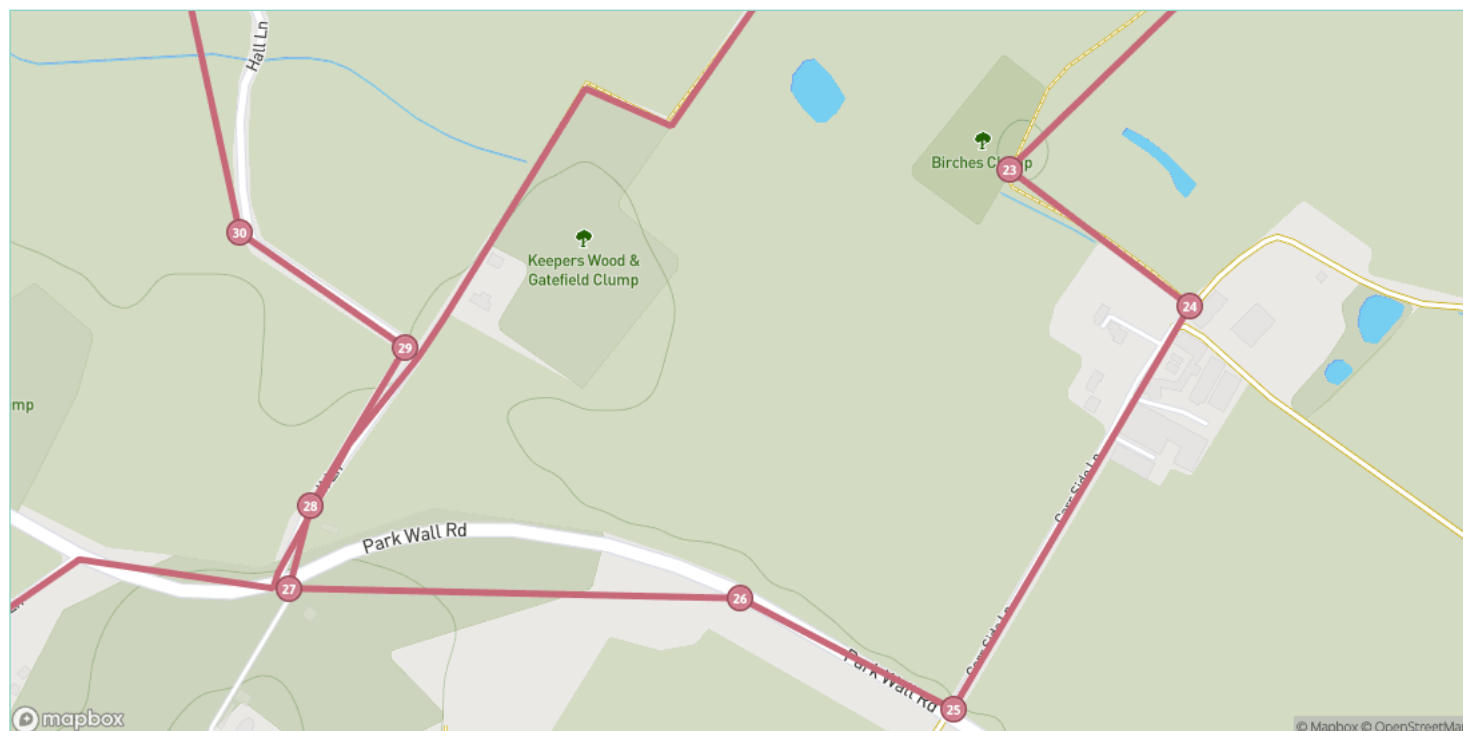
Step 18: Continue around the field as it bends left.

Step 19: You will eventually see a gate on your left, turn right before reaching the gate and walk along the track.

Step 20: Follow the track with the line of trees on your left. You can see how flat Sefton and the surrounding area is. The view stretches for miles.

Step 21: Continue along a grassy path, following the telegraph poles. You will arrive at a small wooden bridge.

Step 22: Walk across the small wooden bridge and immediately turn right. You should be able to see farm buildings in the distance.



Step 23: Walk along the edge of the field, heading towards the farm buildings. Turn left after arriving at the small wood on the right.

Step 24: The path will lead you to Carr Side Lane and the farm you could see from the small wooden bridge. Turn right and walk along Carr Side Lane.

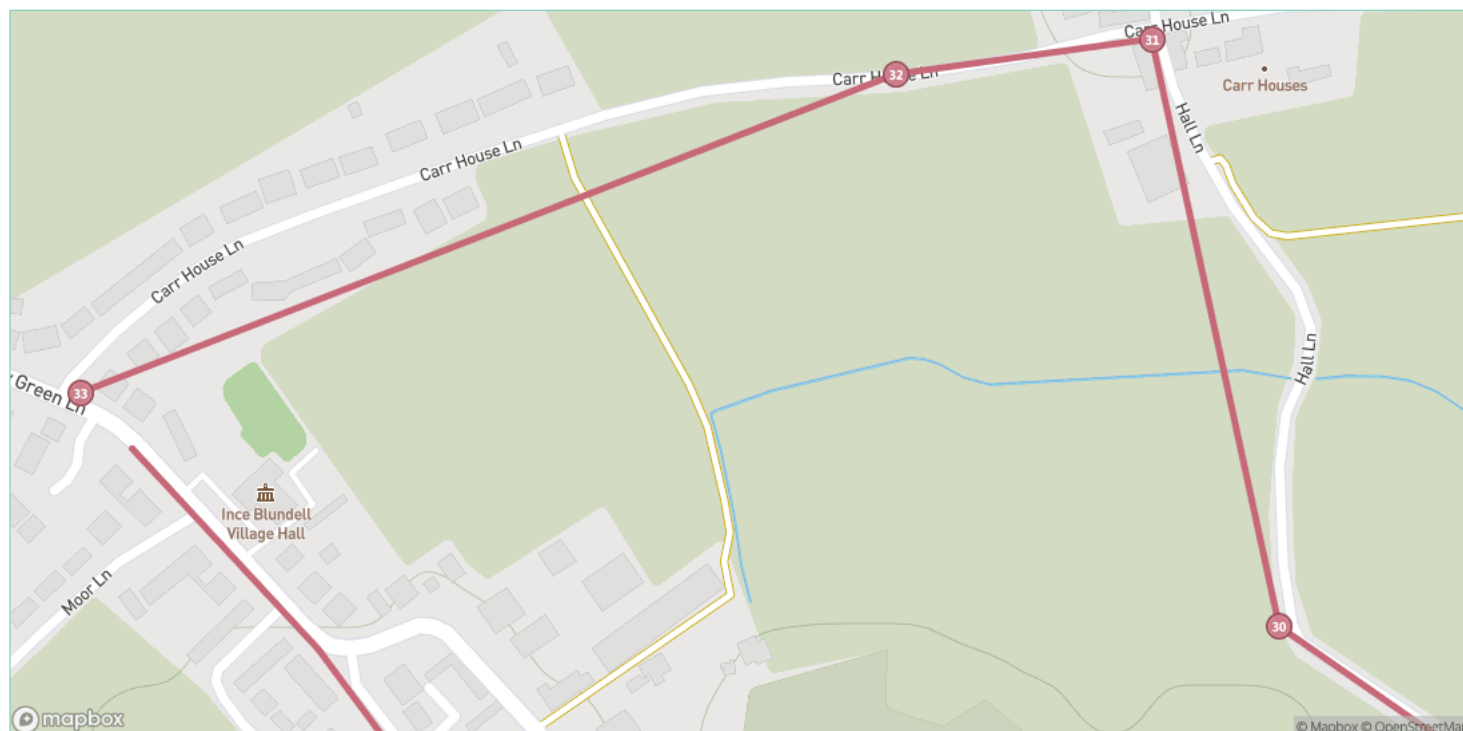
Step 25: After walking past the gate at the end of Carr Side Lane, cross the road and turn right.

Step 26: Walk along the pavement and the perimeter wall of Ince Blundell Hall.

Step 27: You are back at the entrance for Ince Blundell Hall. Turn right and carefully cross the road onto Hall Lane.

Step 28: Walk along Hall Lane, again be aware of moving vehicles.

Step 29: Turn left and continue on Hall Lane.

Step 31: You will arrive at a T junction, turn left and walk along Carr House Lane.

Step 32: Carr House Lane, leading you back to the start of this walk.

Step 33: Well Done you have finished this walk.
