



Hatton Hill Park and Canal Loop

A walk through Hatton Hill Park and along the Leeds and Liverpool Canal

Distance 2.2 kilometers / 1.4 miles

Duration 50 minutes

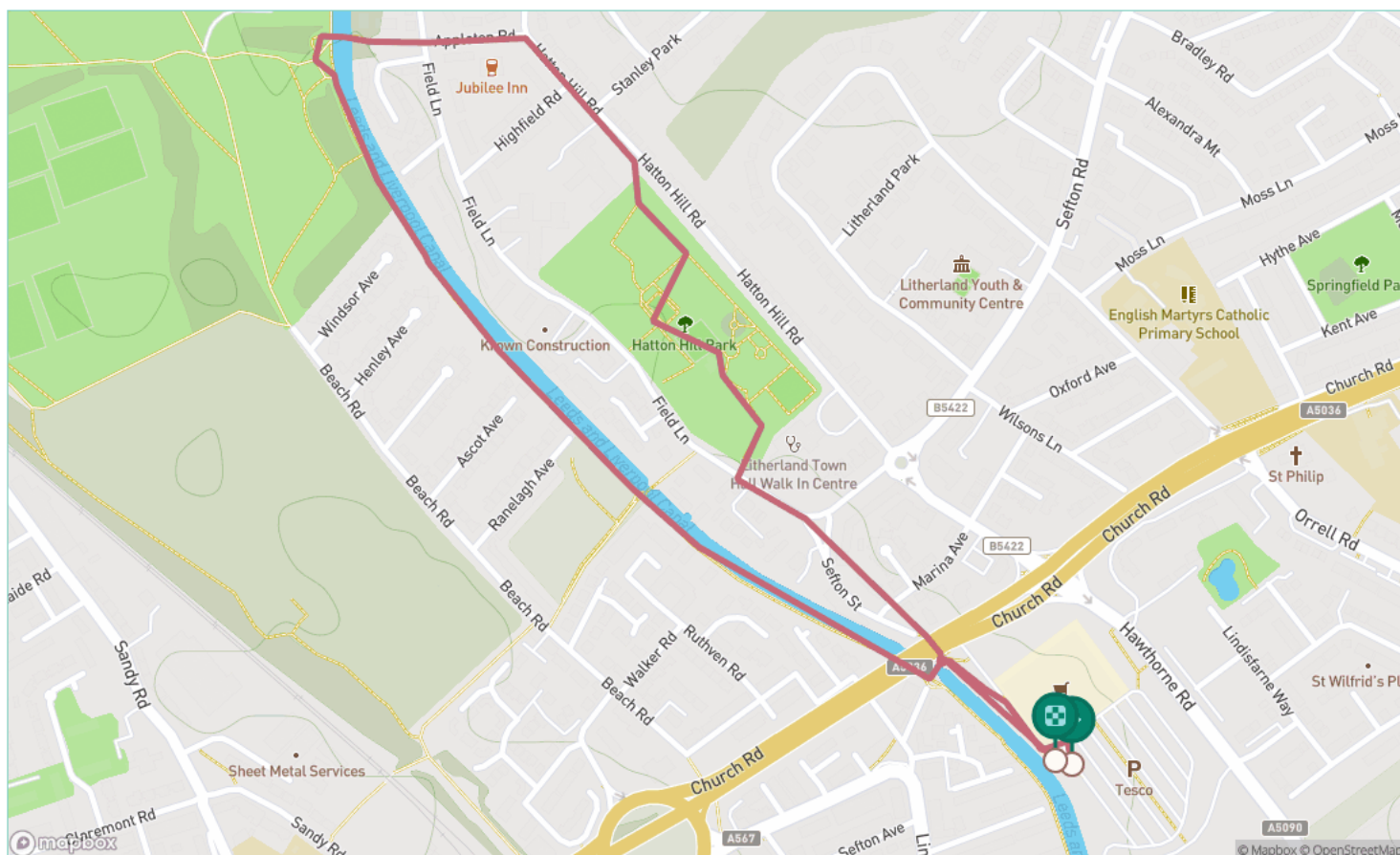

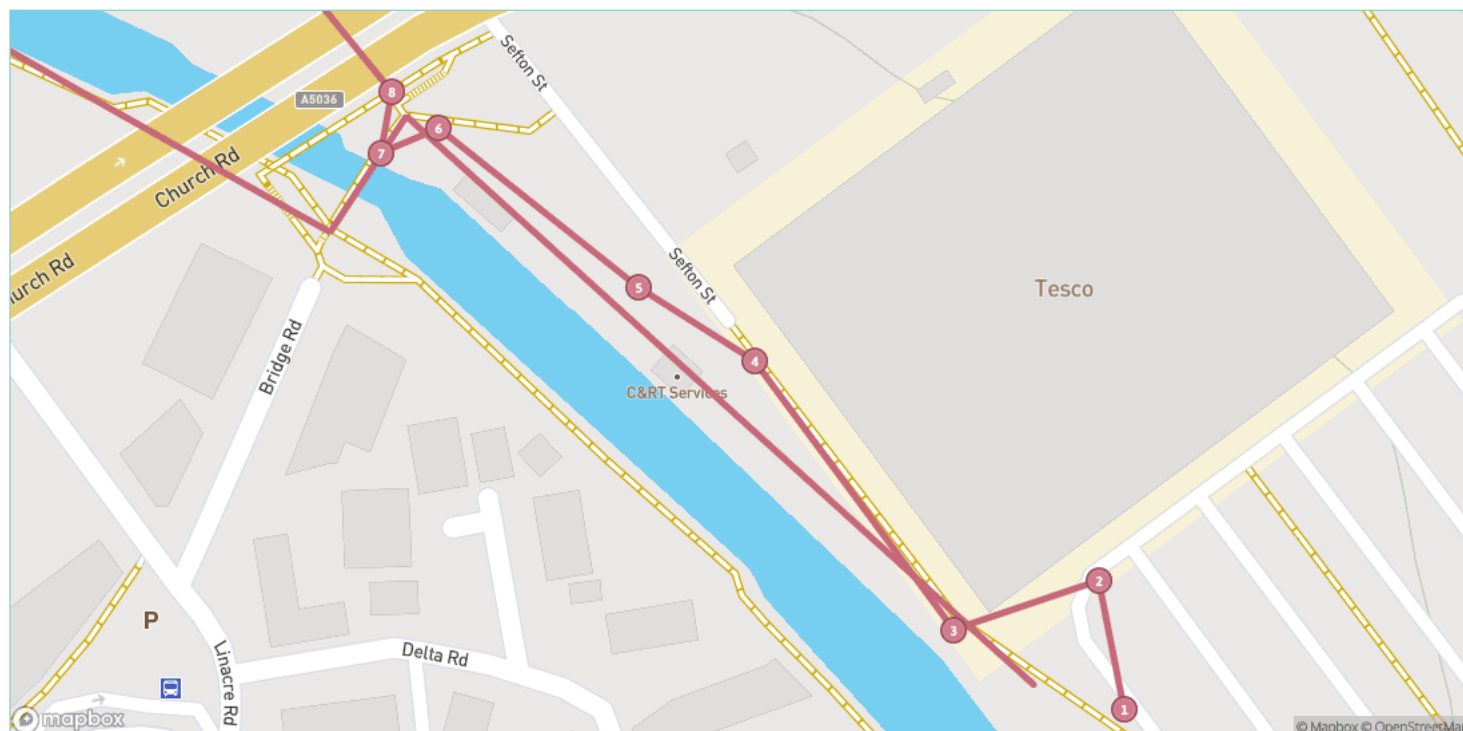

Disclaimer: Directions are provided as guidance only. Weather, construction, closures or other factors may affect routes. Please take care when crossing roads and avoid private land. Always follow local signage and use common sense.
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Step 1: Start your walk from Tesco Litherland.

Step 2: Just to the right of the car park is a bus stop for the 52 bus that goes into central Liverpool and to Netherton.

Step 3: Head right on the footpath at the side of Tesco Litherland (cafe end) to get to the Leeds and Liverpool Canal.

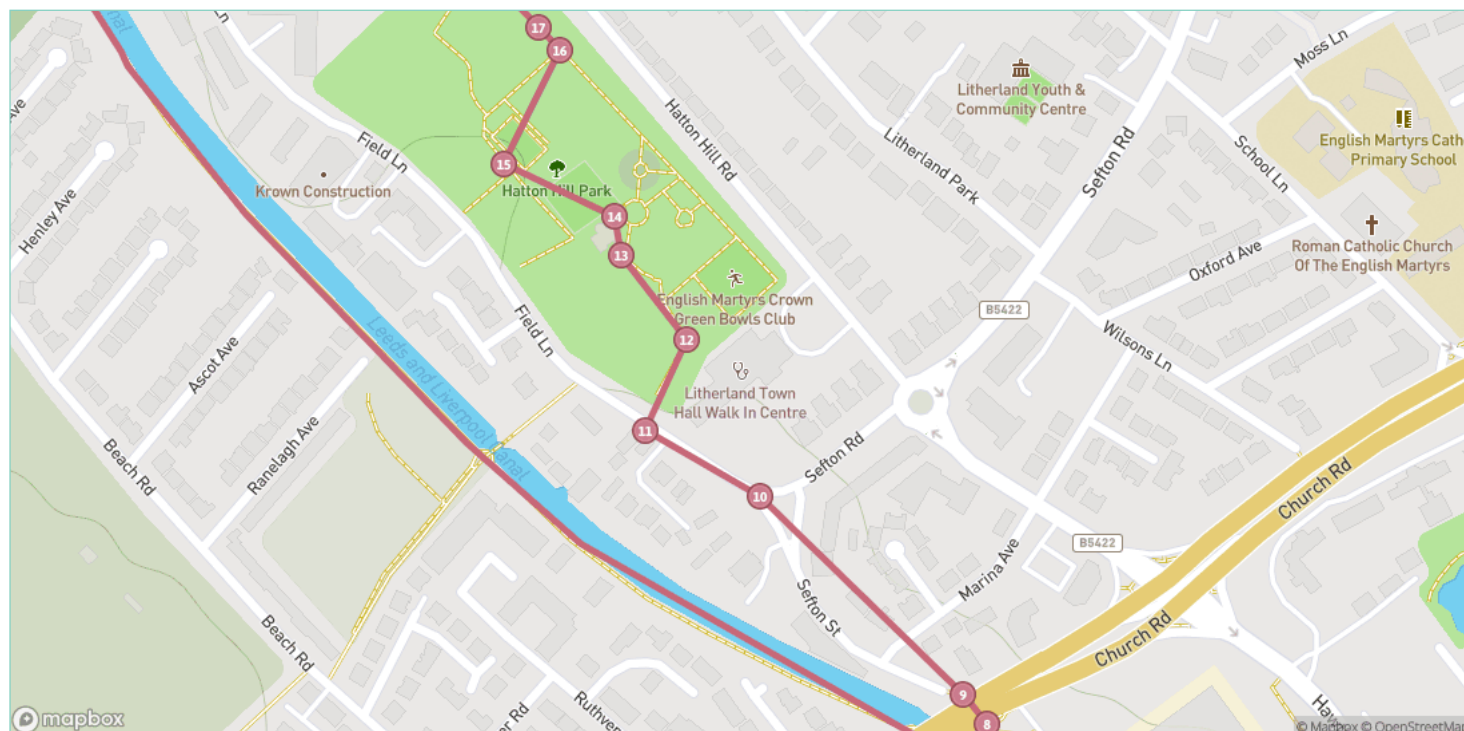
Step 4: Continue on to the next footpath ahead of you.

Step 5: -

Step 6: You will arrive at the canal and the swing bridge. You will cross the swing bridge later on in the route.

Step 7: Canal Swing bridge

Step 8: Use the subway to get to the other side of Sefton Street.



Step 9: You are now on Sefton Street, use the pavement on the left.

Step 10: At the end of the street, turn left onto Field Lane.

Step 11: When on Field Lane, you will see an entrance into Hatton Hill Park on the right. Cross over Field Lane and enter the park.

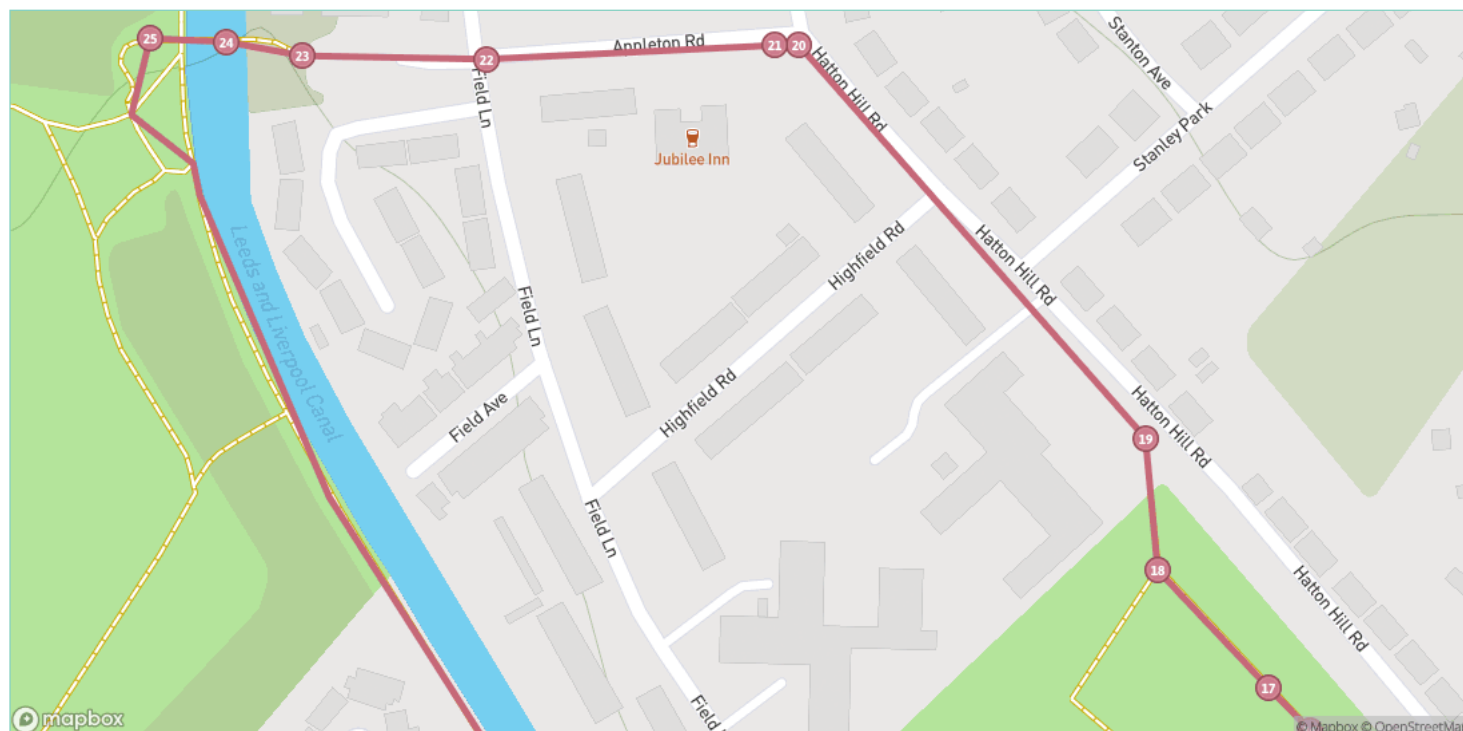
Step 12: Turn left along the avenue of trees, towards the park pavilion.

Step 13: -

Step 14: At the roundabout turn left.

Step 15: Continue along the main path as it bends to the right and towards the perimeter of the park.

Step 16: Turn left and walk towards the parks exit.



Step 17: You can see the large cranes at Seaforth Docks in the distance.

Step 18: Leave the park through the gateway and turn left.

Step 19: Walk along the pavement for a while.

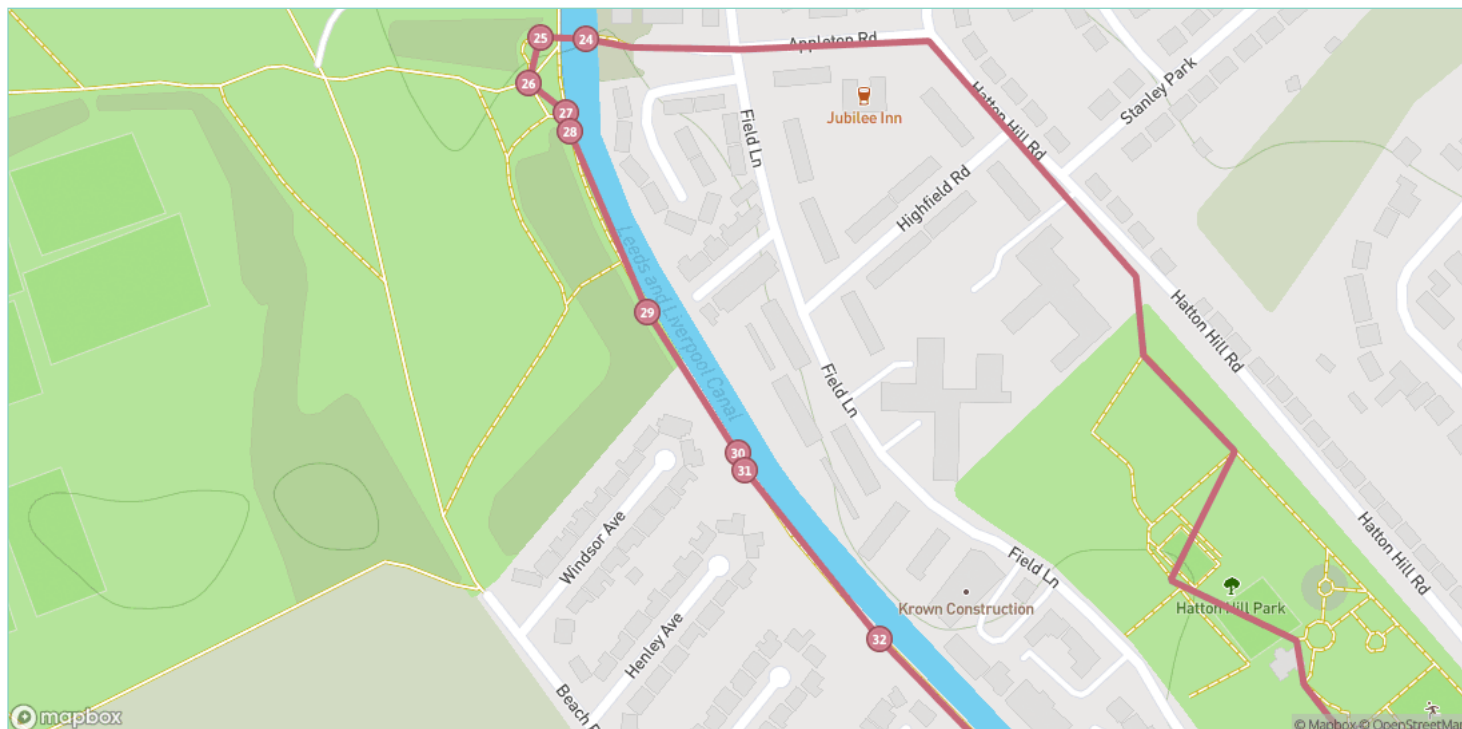
Step 20: When you reach the Jubilee Inn Pub, turn left onto Appleton Road and head towards the canal.

Step 21: Appleton Road

Step 22: At the end of Appleton Road, carefully cross over Field Lane and walk ahead to the car park that leads to a footbridge over the canal.

Step 23: Use the footbridge to get to the towpath on the other side of the canal.

Step 24: Great view of the canal from the footbridge.



Step 25: Continue over the bridge as it bends around to the left.

Step 26: Take the second footpath on the left to get on to the canal towpath.

Step 27: Turn right onto the canal.

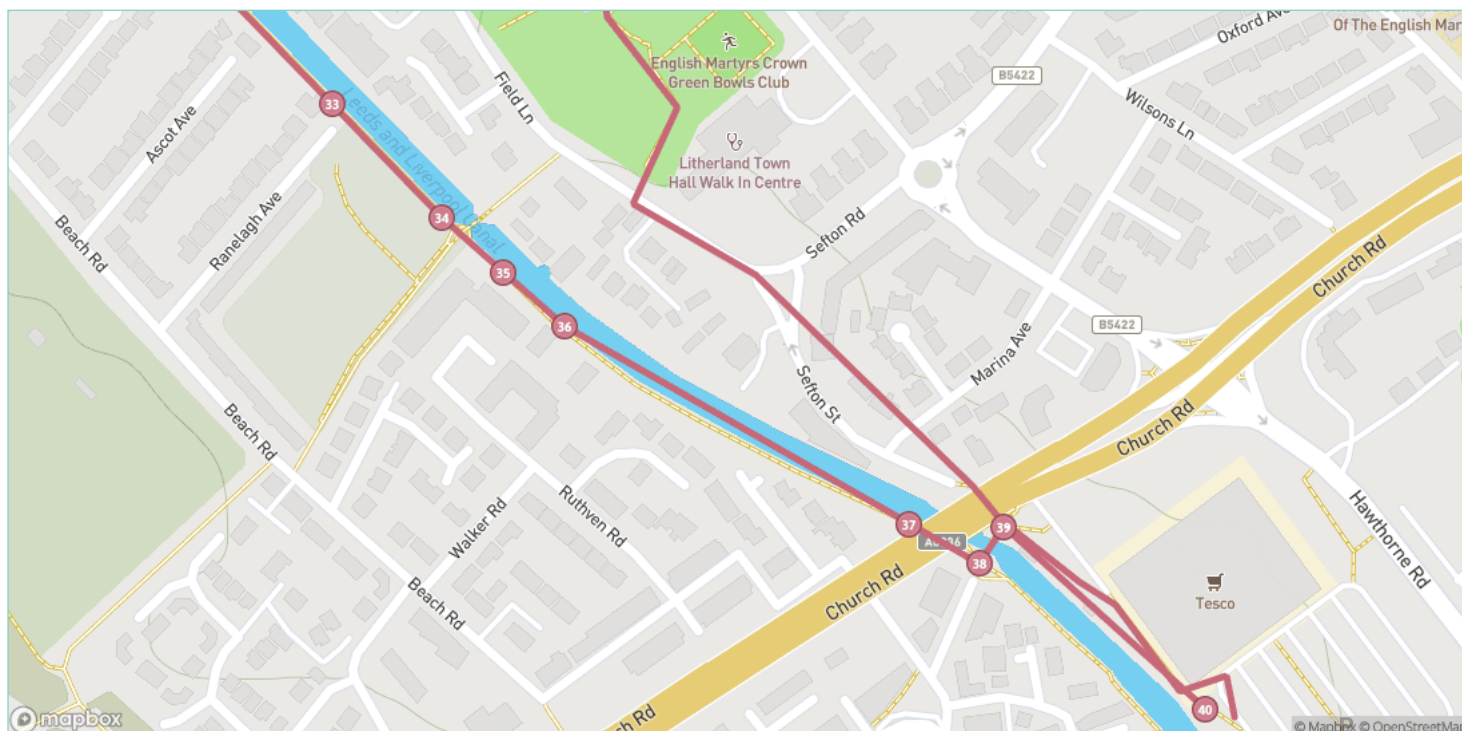
Step 28: Through the gate.

Step 29: Lots of Water Lilies along the canal.

Step 30: Only 122 miles to Leeds

Step 31: Not too far to travel into Liverpool.

Step 33: There just happens to be a barge coming along the canal.

Step 34: Walk under the footbridge and continue along the towpath.

Step 35: Lookout for the wildlife living on and in the canal.

Step 36: And the wildlife alongside the canal too, like this Red Admiral butterfly.

Step 37: Not far to go now, walk under the bridge and spot the canal swing bridge from earlier.

Step 38: Cross the canal swing bridge on the left.

Step 39: After crossing the swing bridge, the footpath back to Tesco is on the right, behind the brick wall. You've finished your walk, well done.

Step 40: Head back to the Tesco carpark to get a bus back into central Liverpool.
