Longer walk starting at the GP to Guisborough Forest. Steps and dropped kerbs as well as slopes and some uneven ground.

Distance 6.2 kilometers / 3.8 miles

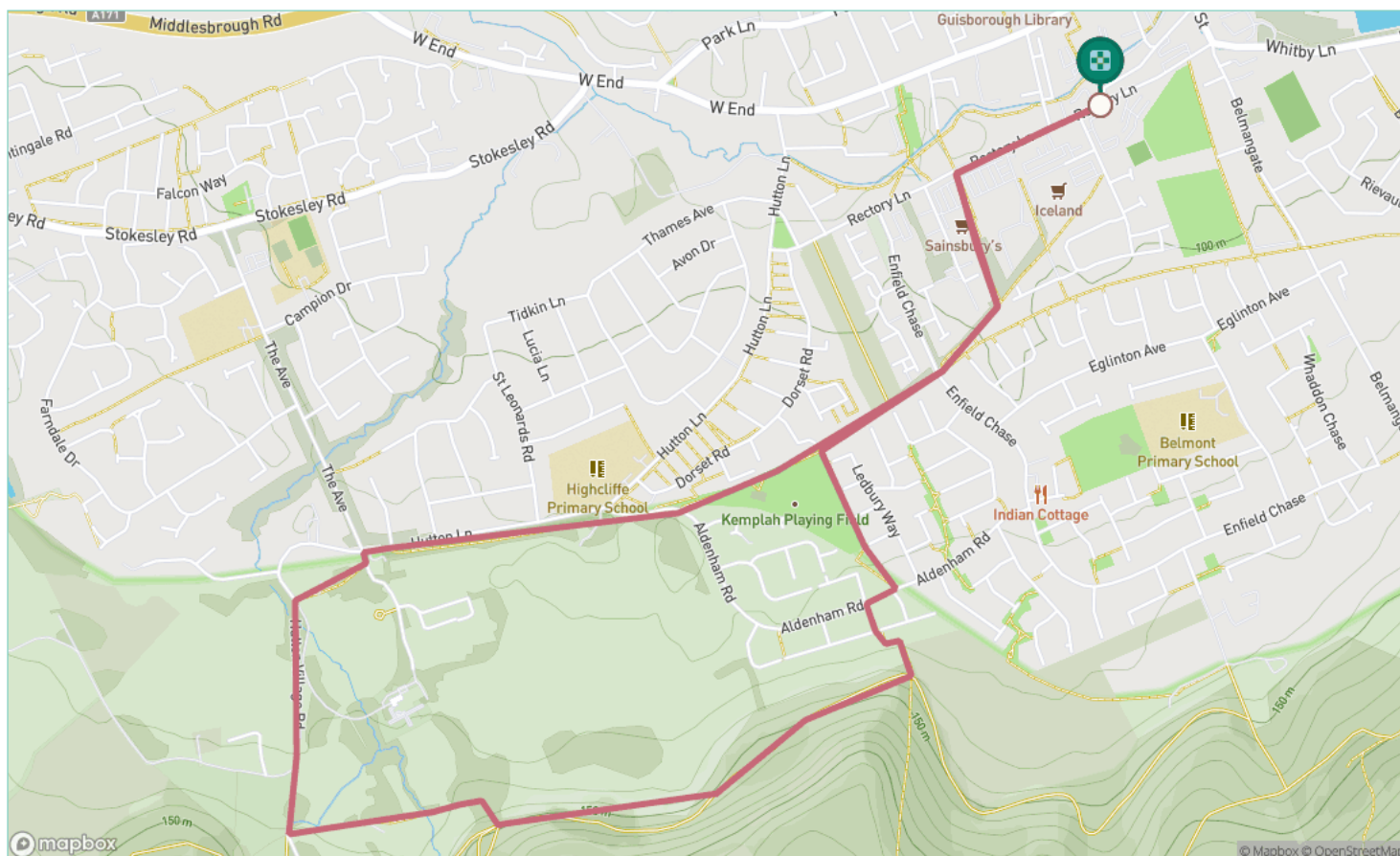

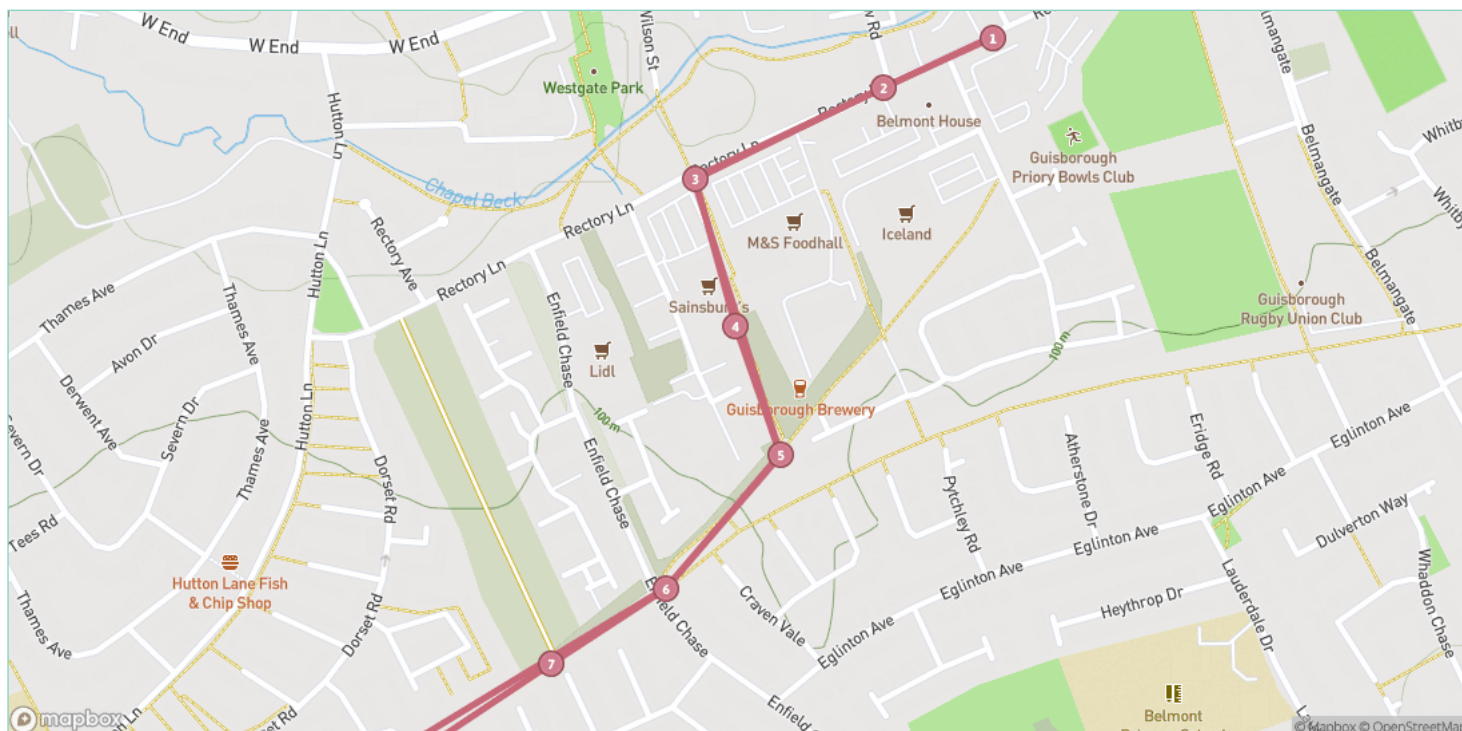

Step 1: Starting from the Garth Surgery, turn left on Rectory Lane

Step 2: Continue along Rectory Road until you reach the Sainsbury's and the public footpath sign

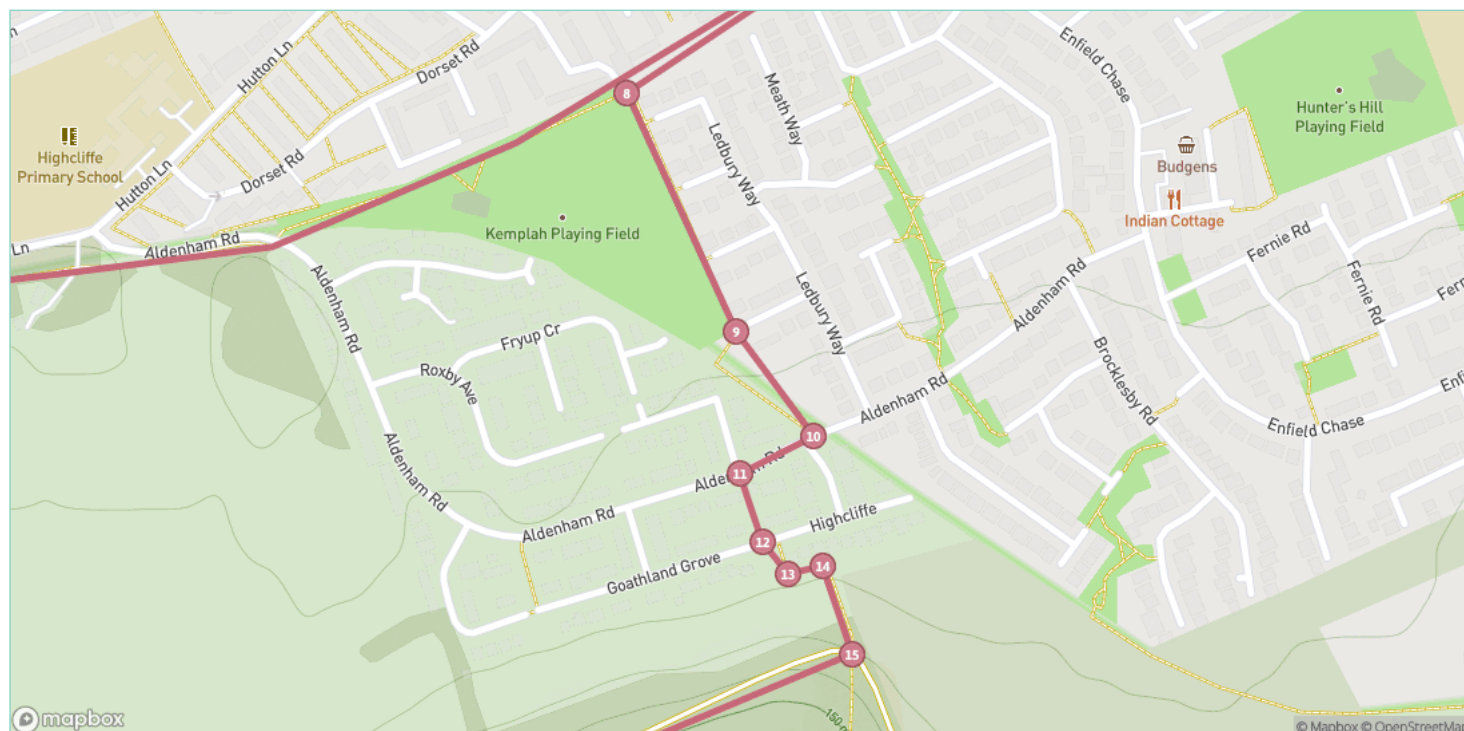
Step 3: Turn left to follow the sign for the public footpath by Sainsbury's.

Step 4: Continue along the woodland path, a welcome change from the built environment.

Step 5: At the sign for the walkway, continue to the right following the sign for the visitor centre.

Step 6: At the signs, cross Enfield Chase road and follow path for walkway.

Step 7: Continue straight on the wide gravel path.



Step 8: Turn left here through the bollards. Continue on for the visitor centre. Keep walking with houses to your left

Step 15: Turn right to follow signs for the walkway to walk along the edge of the wood.

Step 9: Carry on straight at the crossroads to continue on. The path curves gently to the right and then left.

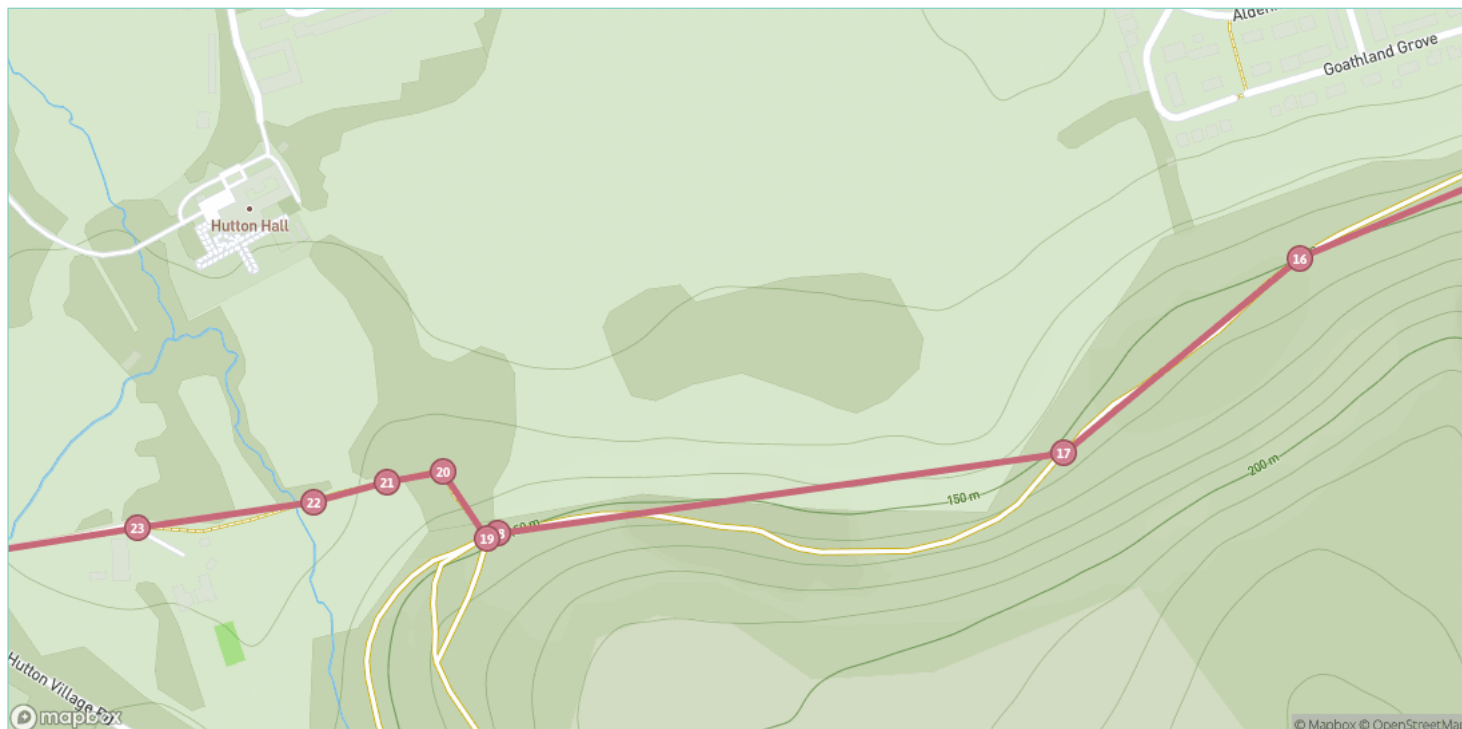
Step 10: Turn right at the post box onto the pavement of Aldenham Road.

Step 11: Cross the road and turn left onto this narrow tarmac path.

Step 12: Slight left to continue on straight to the woods.

Step 13: Turn left to walk along the edge of the field.

Step 14: The yellow arrow is for the north moors path. Bear right here around the field.



Step 16: Enjoy the tall trees.

Step 17: Take in the view of Guisborough.

Step 18: When you reach this point, turn right at the steps following the yellow sign shown in the next picture

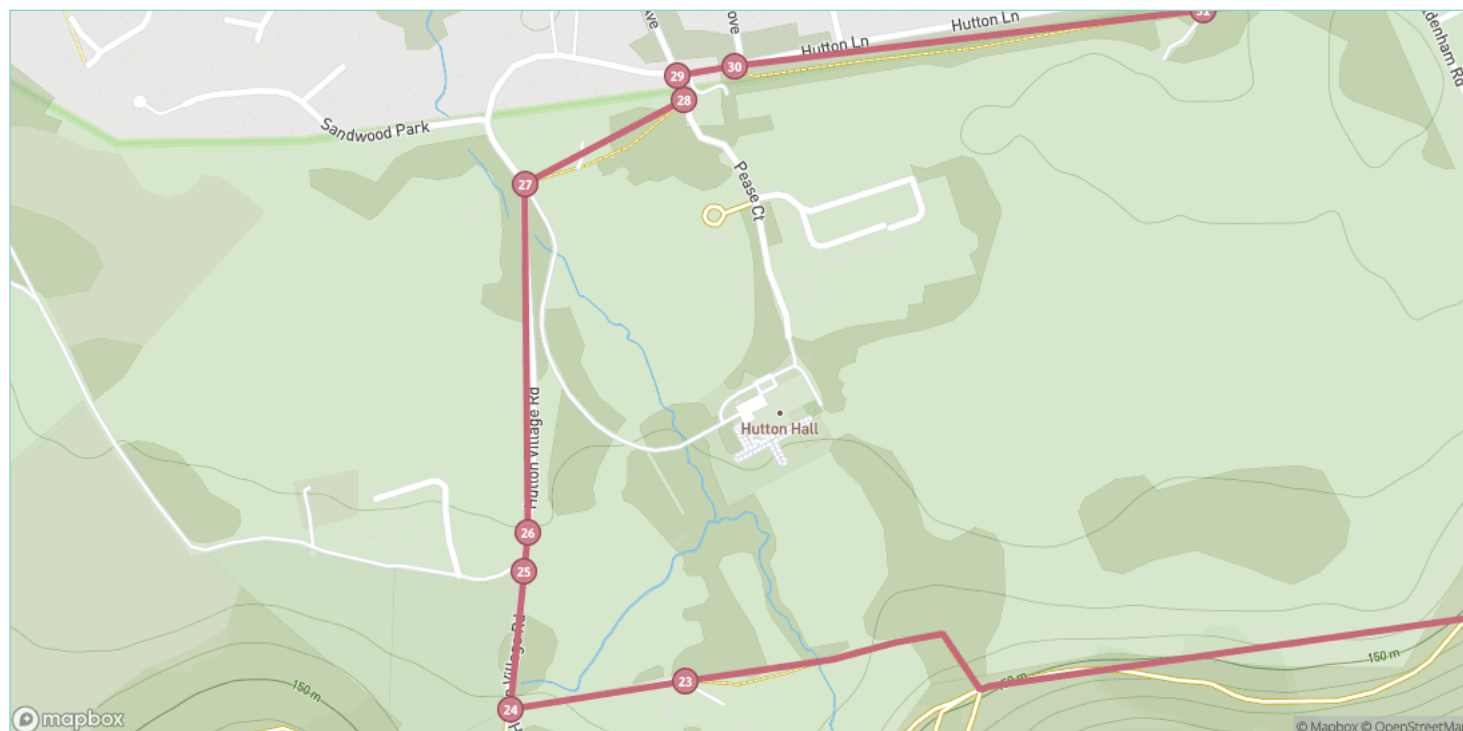
Step 19: Go down the steps and continue into the slightly overgrown path

Step 20: Left here at the path junction and continue round the wooded path

Step 21: Continue straight with Hutton hall to your right

Step 22: There are views across to Hutton Hall on your right.

Step 23: Continue down the road past the fields with horses and cows



Step 24: Turn right here to walk on part of Forestry England's wellbeing walk. If you cross the road and go straight you could go to the forest.

Step 25: At the crossroads continue straight to head back to the town. You could also turn left to head to the visitor centre if you desired.

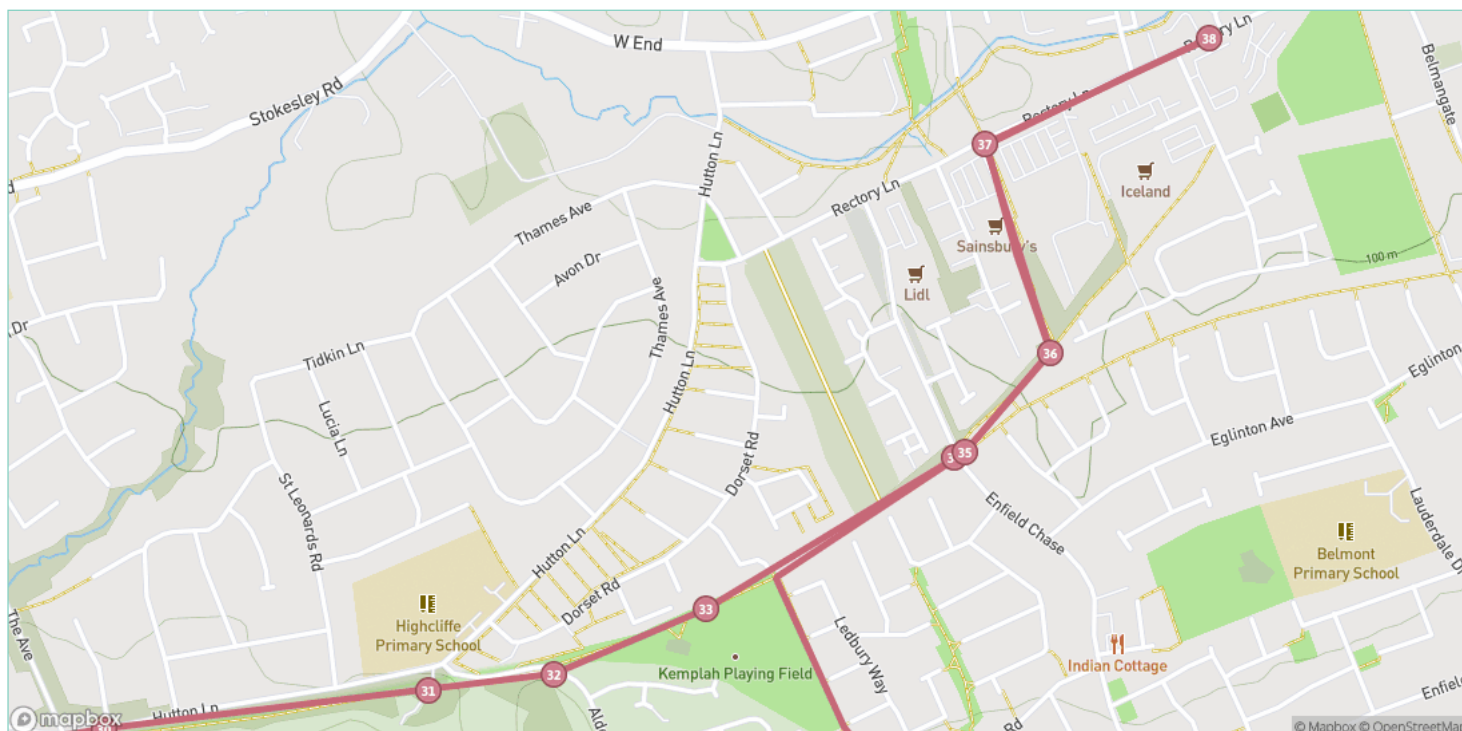
Step 26: Be careful because this section is along a quiet road. Take care when vehicles are approaching.

Step 27: Turn right following the sign for Guisborough

Step 28: Take a left here for the town

Step 29: Now go right on Hutton Lane and pass the bus stop until you reach the next set of signs

Step 30: Cut in right here to continue to the town



Step 31: Carry on straight to return to the town.

Step 32: Follow the sign pointing left and cross the road, continuing on the path on the opposite side.

Step 33: Here you are back at the park where you walked earlier.

Step 34: Cross the road of Enfield Chase to continue back on your walk.

Step 35: Go left at the notice board on the same path from earlier.

Step 36: Left here to head back to the supermarket.

Step 37: Turn right at the sign posts to head back to the Garth Surgery and the town.

Step 38: Well done! You've completed the Garth to Guisborough circuit!
