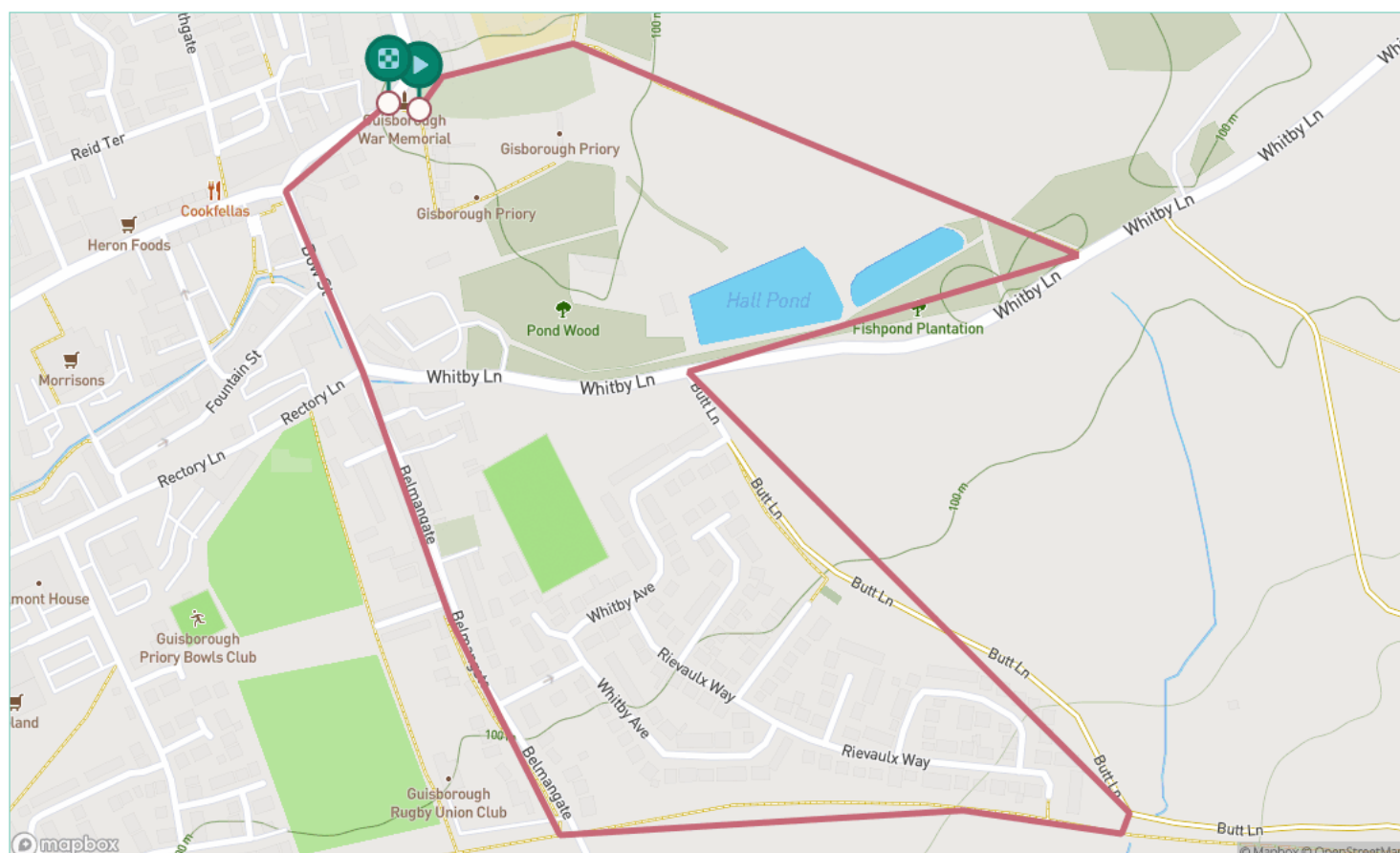

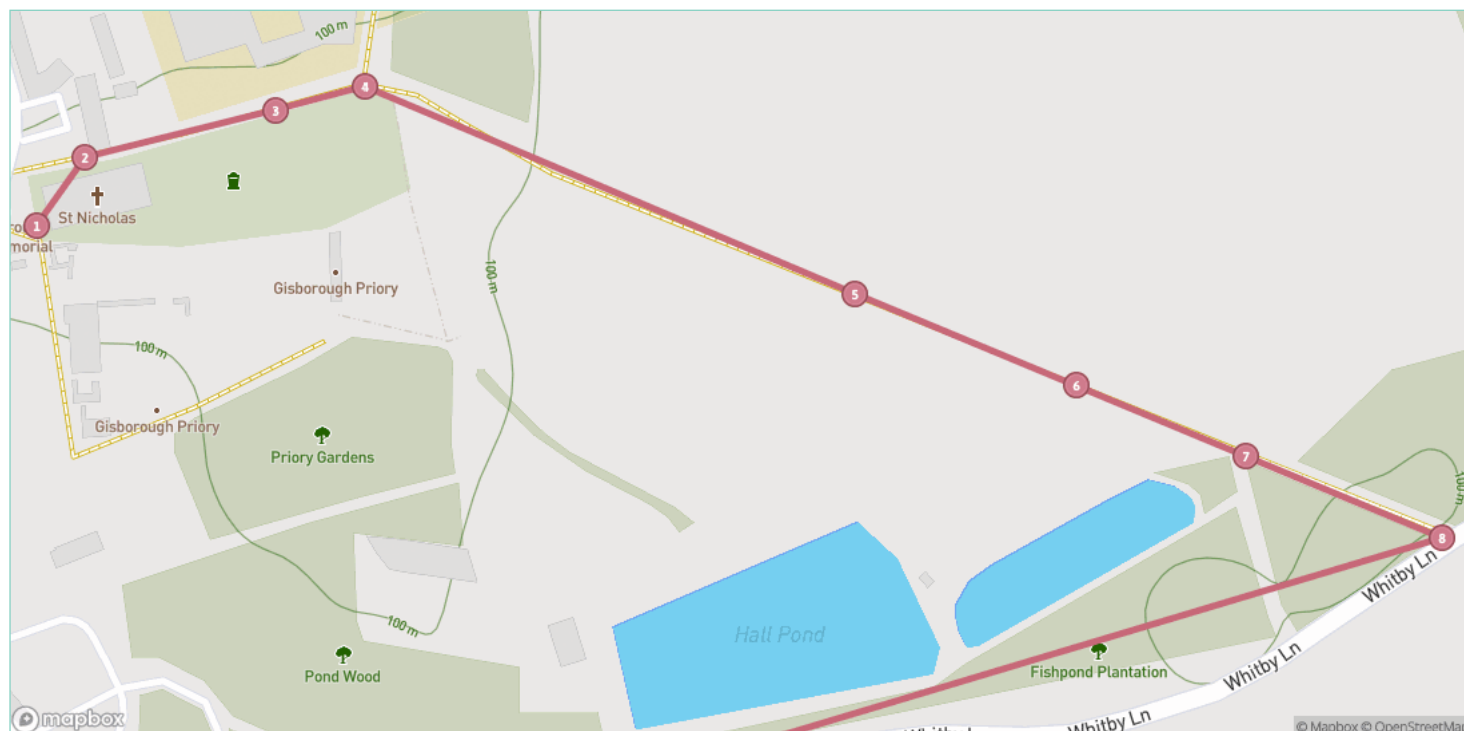

**Step 1:** Begin at the church off Redcar Road. Explore the priory gardens and look at the amazing priory.

**Step 2:** Continue to the left of the priory down the path with the graveyard on your right.

**Step 3:** Continue along this path until you reach the end where you see a woodland

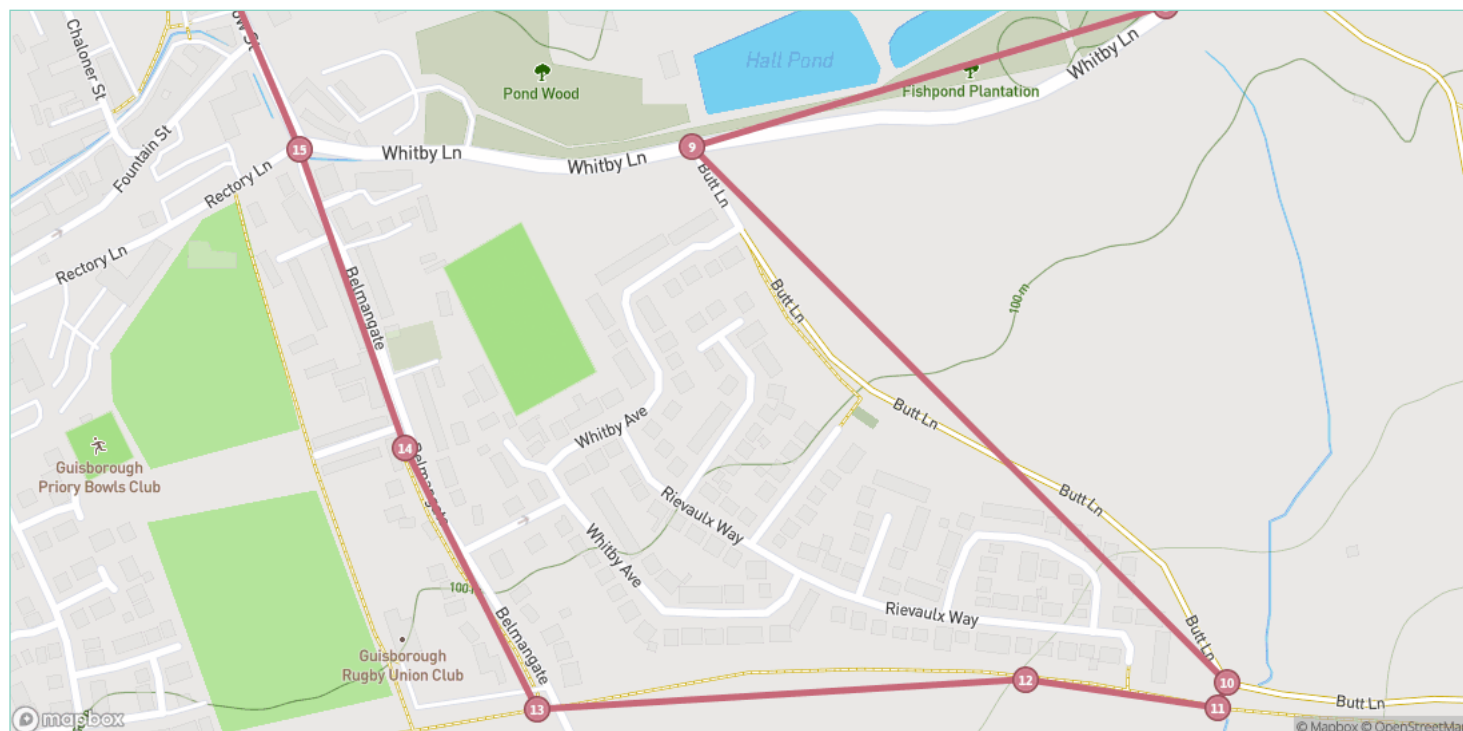
**Step 4:** Here you will reach a gate. Walk through.

**Step 5:** Continue walking along the path through the field. Look back to see the awe-inspiring priory in the distance.

**Step 6:** Keep on walking through the field and look at this lovely oak tree on your right.

**Step 7:** Make your way through this gate to enter the woodland.

**Step 8:** After continuing to walk through the woodland, you will reach another gate. Head through. Turn right on Whitby Lane.



**Step 9:** Once you arrive at Butt Lane, cross Whitby Lane and begin to walk down Butt Lane.

**Step 10:** Continue down Butt Lane until you reach the path junction and the path sign. Take the right turn for Guisborough market town.

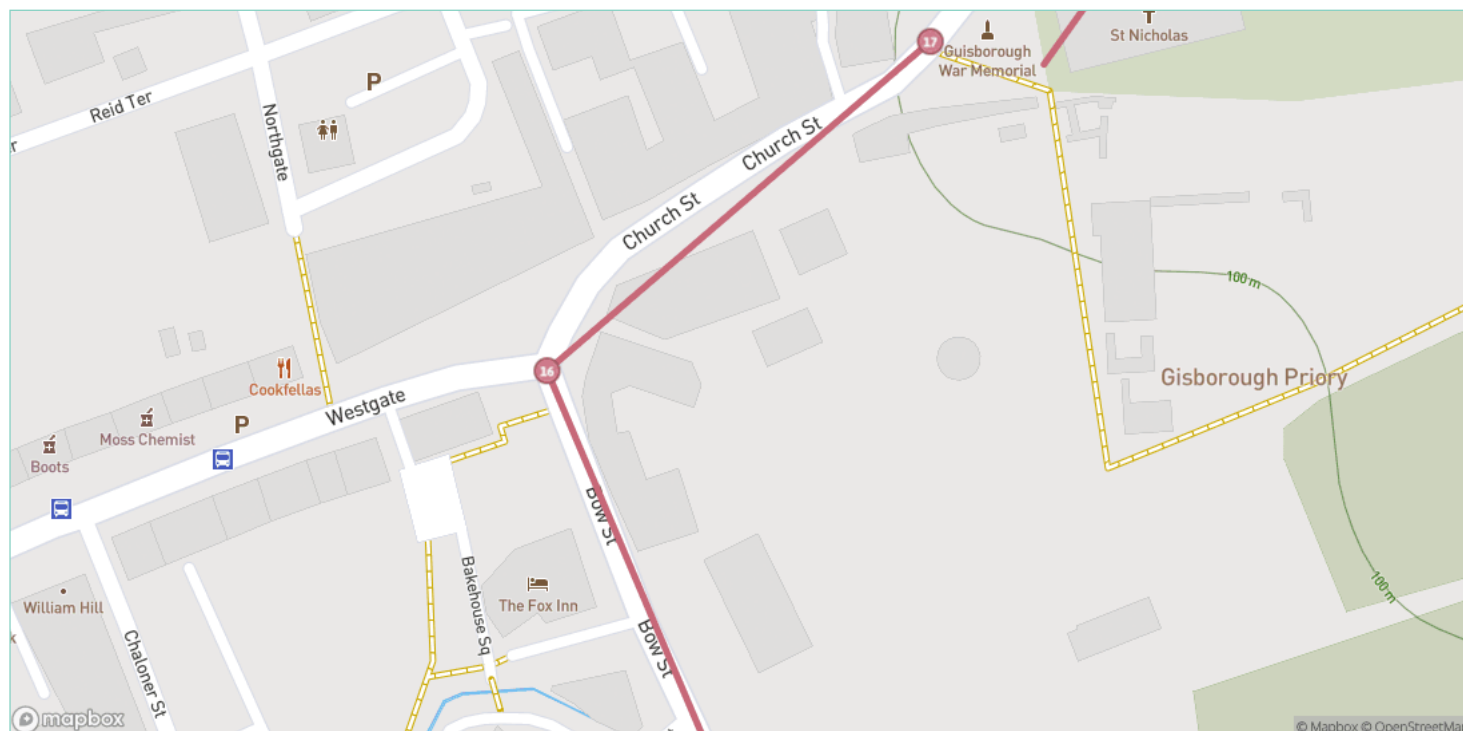
**Step 11:** Take the right turn and walk along the path.

**Step 12:** Continue along this path

**Step 13:** Once you reach Belmangate, turn right to head back to the town centre.

**Step 14:** Continue along Belmangate road

**Step 15:** Cross Whitby Lane to arrive onto Bow Street



**Step 16:** Once you reach the end of Bow Street, take a right turn onto Church Street where you will return back to the priory.

**Step 17:** Walk back to the priory to complete your walk. Have a coffee in a local cafe or admire the church gardens once again before you return home.
